A: According to the registry settings for my system, the following registry value determines whether files with the.html extension open with a Microsoft Internet Explorer program or with the Apache HTTP Server:  
HKEY\_CURRENT\_USER\Software\Microsoft\Windows\CurrentVersion\Explorer\FileExts\.html If the value is not set, a.html file is opened with the Apache HTTP Server. Otherwise, it is opened with Internet Explorer. Setting the registry value to 1 will cause a.html file to open with Internet Explorer. Setting it to 2 will cause the file to open with the Apache HTTP Server. Yajun's Ombud and the 14th Dalai Lama In his new book, The 14th Dalai Lama on Global Governance and Climate Change, editor-in-chief Michael Grunwald tells the story of an unlikely interaction between the Dalai Lama and the ombudsman of the United Nations. Grunwald's book is a collection of 14 speeches given by the Dalai Lama over the past 12 years, in which he explores the subjects of war, peace, and the future of humankind. The 14th Dalai Lama is well-versed in the issues of global governance

and climate change, both of which he believes are influenced by a lack of awareness. As a result, the Dalai Lama often chooses to address the issues head on rather than through the media, where his presence and commentary is less ubiquitous. On multiple occasions, the Dalai Lama has chosen to speak to government leaders directly, which adds another level of authority to his messages. In 2009, the Dalai Lama met with the ombudsman for the United Nations, Mr. Kok Heng Yiin, at the Hanseong University. The meeting was arranged at the request of the Dalai Lama. “The 13th Dalai Lama first met the Ombudsman when he was just a young boy,” says Grunwald. “Since then, the Dalai Lama has met with the Ombudsman on five more occasions. In fact, this was the first time they met in person.” At the time of the meeting, the United Nations was in the middle of negotiating a new climate change agreement, specifically the Durban Conference, which took place from 29 September to 23 October 2009. The Dalai Lama believes that this new agreement will only be effective if the cultural differences between countries are addressed. He feels that economic interests are often greater than 82157476af
